Joseph V. Taranto

Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Everest Re Group, Ltd.

Joseph V. Taranto was named Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Everest in 1994, when the company, then known as Prudential Reinsurance Company, was a subsidiary of The Prudential Insurance Company of America. In 1995, with less than \$700 million in capital, Mr. Taranto led the initial public offering of the



newly-named Everest and steered the company towards becoming one of the top ten reinsurers in the world - now with over \$6 billion in capital and premiums in excess of \$4 billion. Mr. Taranto will retire as CEO of Everest, effective December 31, 2010, but remain on as Chairman of the Board.

With more than thirty-five years in the insurance industry, Mr. Taranto has gained significant insight into the global property and casualty market sectors. He is an acknowledged leader and visionary, having established a superior long-term track record of performance.

Prior to joining Everest, Mr. Taranto spent nineteen years at AIG. As a graduate of Brooklyn College and a Fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society (FCAS), he began his career at AIG in 1975 in the actuarial department and quickly distinguished himself as a leader within this large organization. He rapidly advanced to become manager of the actuarial department and then moved to underwriting to become Senior Vice President at the AIG subsidiary, National Union. In 1986, Mr. Taranto was named President of Transatlantic, a private company and affiliate of AIG, whose sole source of business was AIG. Under Mr. Taranto's leadership, Transatlantic was transformed into a global reinsurer with clients throughout the world. In 1990, Mr. Taranto successfully led the initial public offering of Transatlantic where he remained President until assuming his new role at Everest in 1994.

In addition to his business pursuits, Mr. Taranto has been an active member of the Board of Directors of Heartshare Human Services of NY for the last seven years. HeartShare is a non-profit community-based organization focused on providing a wide range of services to children and adults with developmental disabilities, families in crisis, and people with HIV/AIDS. For nearly 100 years, HeartShare has helped New Yorkers develop to their fullest potential and lead meaningful lives.
