12:15 pm Costs and Pricing: No Contract is Really Final

- <u>Three Phases</u>: (1) Proposal; (2) Performance and billing; and (3) Final payment
 - <u>Proposals</u>: Forward pricing rates, Cost Accounting Standards, Truth in Negotiations Act (TINA), and FAR Part 31 "Cost Principles"
 - <u>Performance and billing</u>: Progress payments based on costs (for FFP and FPI contracts); Performance based billing/milestone billing; T&M billing based on hours worked and actual costs for material; "Public vouchers" for cost-reimbursement contracting; and all bills subject to periodic audit and testing
 - <u>Final payment</u>: FFP contracts, cost-reimbursement contracts, FPI contract, and T&M contracts
- <u>Post-award Price Adjustments</u>: FAR Part 31 allowability rules; TINA; and CAS
